During your stay with us you'll be in your own private world, but still close enough to the mainland of Belize where you can enjoy some of the most exciting jungle and ruin adventures this diverse Central American country has to offer. Lagoon Rooms-

Lagoon rooms are located in a hotel style building by the Laguna De Mata. They are newly renovated and decorated with cool Caribbean colors and rich woods. Four poster hand carved mahogany beds with decorative veiling, and Egyptian cotton towels with high thread count bedding. Most Lagoon Rooms have ethnic hand carved art displays on walls. Lagoon rooms have spectacular views of Laguna de Mata with all its wildlife, fauna, and vegetation. They have 2 double beds or 1 king bed. Each room is equipped with a large private bathroom, air-conditioning, mini-refrigerator, coffee maker, hair dryer, ceiling fan, and a large deco walk in shower.

Lagoon Suites-

Lagoon Suites are newly renovated, and decorated with cool Caribbean colors and rich woods. Lagoon Suites have a balcony, and include Four poster hand carved mahogany beds with decorative veilings, ethnic hand carved art displays on walls, and Egyptian cotton towels with high thread count bedding. Lagoon Suites have spectacular views of Laguna de Mata with all its wildlife, fauna, and vegetation. They have 1 King bed with a separate living room, equipped with kitchenette. The living room sofa pulls out into a queen size bed. Each room is equipped with 2 private large bathrooms, air-conditioning, mini-refrigerator, coffee maker, hair dryer, ceiling fan, and large deco walk in showers.



Ocean Front Cabanas-

These are newly renovated free standing private cabanas. They are decorated with cool Caribbean colors and rich woods. Ocean Front cabanas have Queen size four poster hand carved mahogany beds with decorative veilings, ethnic hand carved art displays on walls, and Egyptian cotton towels with high thread count bedding. They have amazing views of the Caribbean Sea and sugar white beaches. Each cabana is equipped with a private large bathroom, air-conditioning, mini-refrigerator, coffee maker, hair dryer and ceiling fan, and large deco walk in showers. They are about 280 SQ ft. larger than Lagoon Rooms.

Pool / Garden Cabanas-

These are renovated free standing private cabanas. They are decorated with cool Caribbean colors and rich woods. Pool / Garden cabanas have four poster hand carved mahogany beds with decorative veilings, ethnic hand carved art displays on walls, and Egyptian cotton towels with high thread count bedding. Pool/Garden cabanas have lovely views of the pool or lushly landscaped tropical gardens. They are available with 2 Double beds or 1 King bed. Each cabana is equipped with a private large bathroom, air-conditioning, mini-refrigerator, and coffee maker, hair dryer and ceiling fan, and large deco walk in showers. All cabanas have a private terrace.



Open Water Certification-

The PADI Open Water Diver course is divided into three segments: academic training, confined water training, followed by four open water dives. Academic training gives you the basic principles and knowledge you will need for safe and enjoyable diving. Confined water training takes place in our pool, and will teach you the basic skills of diving. The four open water dives allow you to demonstrate your mastery of these skills and practice them in a typical diving situation while enjoying the underwater sights of Belize.

Referral Certification-

The referral consists of four open water dives in order to complete your certification. Two dives a day, either in the morning or afternoon at the reef, allows you to complete the necessary skills while developing your confidence in the big blue.

Advance Certification-

The course is made up of three core dives, a navigation dive, a night dive, and a deep dive. You will also make two elective dives that you will choose with your PADI instructor. Elective dives to choose from are peak buoyancy control, a boat dive, a drift dive, a multi-level dive, an underwater naturalist dive, a wreck dive, or an underwater photography dive. That makes a total of five dives that can be completed in as quickly as two days. The Advanced Open Water Diver course is a good choice for those interested in not only exploring the reef, but also in advancing their underwater experience.

Nitrox Dive Certification-

This program provides recreational divers a safer breathing medium for enjoying dives in 40 fsw (12 msw) to 130 fsw (39 msw) depth range. The diver may elect to dive the mix on EANx tables or conservatively using their dive computers or air tables with an added diver safety margin. The IANTD Nitrox Diver certification is adaptable to being taught as a single program or by combining it with a variety of advanced or specialty diver courses.

Divemaster-

This program is designed to provide responsible training for those persons wishing to supervise standard IANTD divers, including Nitrox Divers, Advanced Nitrox Divers and Deep Air Divers. IANTD Nitrox Divemasters may supervise and assist in all open water IANTD diver programs but cannot conduct training exercises unless under the direction of a qualified IANTD instructor.

Diving & Snorkeling Two tank dive-

Please visit our on site dive shop for information, scheduling & renting gear. The dive shop opens at 8:00am and usually closes around 5:00pm. Snorkeling can be done either right in front of the property or out on the reef. Load your gear on a kayak, paddle out about 12 minutes to the reef and tie up to one of our mooring balls. You can snorkel in 3-6 feet of water until your heart is content.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy to advanced

Mexico Rocks Snorkeling-

This is an extensive patch reef system with the greatest coral and sponge diversity in all of Belize. There is also a 40-year old pontoon wreck and an underwater cave at Mexico Rocks.

Hol Chan Park-

The Hol Chan Marine Park (Hol Chan is Mayan for Little Channel) is situated north of Caye Caulker. Declared the first marine park in the entire country of Belize, it is a zone protected area. Due to its protected status, what was once a depleted fishing area has now been allowed to re-generate. It produces to divers and snorkelers alike quite a colorful and varied fish spectacle. You will see rays, sharks, and other marine life during this trip.

Caye Caulker Snorkel-

Visit the Bohemian island of Caye Caulker, and experience the people. It is only a short distance away but a world apart.

Blue Hole Dives-

Day trip to the Blue Hole including three spectacular dives. Six miles north of Halfmoon Caye, in the lagoon of Lighthouse Atoll, is the Great Blue Hole. The name alone will make it different from some of the other "blue holes" to be found in the Caribbean. Dive as deep as 150 ft. in the Blue Hole. This one is the largest, deepest, and most famous. Thousands of divers have made it the reason they have come to dive in Belize.

The Elbow-

One of the 70 dive sites waiting to be sampled at Turneffe is the "Elbow", located on the extreme southern end of the atoll. With a 3,000-foot wall and some converging currents filled with nutrients, this can be one of the most exciting dives anyone can do in the Caribbean.



Reef & Flats Fishing-

For full days of organized fishing we recommend that guests hire one of our guides and visit the many offshore and flats areas. However, if you would simply like to walk the beach in front of the property you will find many opportunities to catch bonefish and permit on your own. The Journey's End dock and the dive shop dock offer some fun fishing for small snapper, barracuda and other assorted reef fish. Don't forget about the lagoon for fishing too. You can either fish off of the kayak dock or paddle back into some of the small islands just a few minutes away and catch an assortment of fish. Rental rods and tackle are available.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy

Flats Fishing-

1/2 day or Full day

The flats of Belize are considered to be some of the best saltwater fishing grounds in the world. If you're looking to hook into bonefish, permit, tarpon, and snook, this is the place to be. Our guides will take you to the best areas and put you on top of the fish ~ then it's up to you. Guides are only marginally equipped with gear and or tackle so plan on bringing your own. ORVIS fly fishing rental gear and flies are available at our tour office.

Level of difficulty ~ Moderate

Reef Fishing-

Travel out on the second largest barrier reef in the world with our experienced local fisherman in search of today's local catch. The assortment of fish caught might include snapper, grouper, jacks, barracuda or who knows what! Your guide will bring along bait and an ice chest with water. You bring the rod, reel and tackle.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy

The Explorations



Lamanai Maya Ruins Boat - Air

Lamanai or "submerged crocodile" is one of the most mystical sites you can visit while in Belize. Depart by boat, head up a mainland river, grab a van ride to Sugar City, then jump on another boat and see Orange Walk. Visit the museum and hike into the jungle where you'll discover the Ancient Maya ruins of Lamanai. Bring along comfortable wearing apparel, shoes that will not slip, binoculars, camera and sun block.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy to moderate

Xunantunich Maya Ruins

Xunantunich "Stone Lady", is an impressive archeological site with its tallest structure rising 130ft. above the jungle canopy. After traveling back to the mainland you'll see rolling hills, winding rivers, and the ancient land of the Maya. This tour will help enhance your understanding of the Maya while enjoying the rich history of this center. Bring extra clothes, hiking shoes, and a swimsuit. Lunch and soft drinks are included.

Level of difficulty ~ Moderate

Tikal -

This is undoubtedly the most researched and excavated Maya ruin site throughout Central America. The trip takes you from Belize into the jungle regions of Guatemala where you will have the opportunity to study the extensive archaeological sites continuously being uncovered. This trip can also be offered as an overnight trip by land that gives you more time to enjoy these incredible ruins. Bring hiking shoes, sunscreen, and your camera.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy to moderate

Lagoon Kayak Tour -

Join one of our trained staff members for a lagoon kayak tour behind our property. It's common for guests to catch a glimpse of crocodiles, juvenile fish populations, and a variety of rare birds, endemic to Belize. The canopied canal ways leading from lagoon to lagoon serve up orchids, termite nests, and a host of other interesting sights.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy to moderate

Bicycles -

Journey's End Resort has bicycles perfect for cruising up and down the beach. Head south towards town or go north to check out some of the interesting and wonderful sites of the island. We kindly request that guest refrain from taking bicycles into town.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy to moderate

Parasailing-

Enjoy great views of the island and reef from the air. The boat will pick you up and return you to our dock for your ride. Available with 1, 2, or 3 seats.

Mountain Pine Ridge-

The geology of the Mountain Pine Ridge is dominated by ancient rocks. These rocks are among the oldest formations in the Americas. Some geologists theorize that when the sea covered the entire Central American isthmus, only the Mountain Pine Ridge region lay exposed as an island.

Actun Tunichil Mucknal-

Fly into Belize City and travel by van to the Roaring Creek River Valley. There you will hike through the lush tropical rainforest and swim through pristine rivers. Actun Tunichil Mucknal is Belize's premier cave featuring amazing geological features, ancient artifacts, burials and sacrificial alters. Bring extra clothes, hiking shoes and a swimsuit. Lunch and soft drinks are included.

Level of difficulty ~ Moderate

Altun Ha Maya Ruins-

Travel south around Ambergris Caye and north to the village of Bomba. View orchids, water birds and an occasional crocodile. From Bomba, you travel by van 12 miles to the site of Altun Ha Maya for "Rockstone Pond". Altun Ha is one of Belize's smallest archeological sites with its tallest structure being 60 ft. high. Bring along comfortable wearing apparel, shoes that will not slip, your binoculars, camera, and sun block.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy

Sail & Snorkel Caye Caulker ? day-

Sail aboard the "Me Too", a 36ft. McGregor Catamaran. Snorkel the sites with the most prolific fish life on the reef: Hol Chan Reserve and Shark Ray Alley. Enjoy lunch and a stroll through the lobster fishing village of Caye Caulker. Rum punch, beer and soft drinks are included. Bring snorkel gear, lunch money and the Hol Chan park entrance fee.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy

Manatee Safari -

Travel by boat to Belize's only manatee preserve, then snorkel and swim off a beautiful, isolated island and enjoy a relaxing picnic lunch. Two other exciting snorkel stops included and time permitting, a stop at neighboring Caye Caulker. Lunch, beer and soft drinks are included. Make sure to bring snorkel gear.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy

Bacalar Chico Maya Channel Adventure -

Travel north by boat near the Belize/Mexico border. Snorkel, swim and enjoy a fresh lunch prepared on the boat. On this guided tour of Bacalar Chico Nature Reserve you will see birds, fish, and underwater caverns. Experience an ancient Mayan mangrove canal and then troll past famous Rocky Point fishing grounds on the way home.

Level of difficulty ~ Easy

Cave Tubing and Belize Zoo-

Float down Caves Branch River and its winding path through the Maya Mountains and numerous ancient caves once inhabited by the Maya. Upon arriving at Jaguar Paw, be prepared for a 45-minute jungle trail hike. Your guide will point out various plants, roots and herbs once used by the ancient Maya. After lunch you will make a stop at The Belize Zoo, home to an impressive array of large cats, primates, reptiles, and birds.

Cave Tubing and Zip lining By Air-

A transfer from Belize City on the very scenic Western Highway brings you to the Caves Branch River at Jaguar Paw Resort. You will start your day with the Zip line Tour. After lunch be prepared to cross the River and begin to climb as you will hike for 45 minutes down a jungle trail. The entrance tunnel that heads into the underground cave system is the start of an "eye opening" adventure. As you flow down the cool water of the Caves Branch River your adrenaline will be flowing high as this is the adventure of a life time.
